ASPARAGUS -

Production continues to be steady out of Mexico. Best to pre-order Jumbo size.



BRUSSELS SPROUTS -

Good supplies coming out of Salinas. Quality has been very nice overall.



CAULIFLOWER / BROCCOLI - Demand has cooled off so there are abundant supplies of Cauliflower with minor spotting issues being reported. Broccoli crowns are running large. Very good value,



Peppers -

Bell supplies are starting to increase. Quality of Reds starting to improve from last weeks heat issues. Very nice Gypsy and Italian Frying Peppers on hand

ONIONS -

Ideal weather in the growing regions has been a boon for production.



LETTUCE ROMAINE / ICEBERG / LEAF -

Iceberg: Tight market expected to run another week. Minor spotting and pink ribs being reported.



Leaf: Reports of fringe burn starting to die down. Quality improving.

Romaine: Fringe burn and insect damage being reported but over-all quality is good.

SOFT SQUASH



Minor scarring from heat being reported but over-all quality is good.

VEGETABLES / FRUITS



SEASONAL FRUITS -

Black Mission Figs about a week or so away. Champagne Grapes starting up Australian Daisy Tangerines are on hand



AVOCADO -

Labor shortages are holding down production in Mexico. CA is having difficulty keeping up with the demand.



CITRUS -

CA Valencias have taken over !! Navels are DONE.

Limes - currently running 175ct.

BERRIES



Quality has been very good. Strawberries have good color. Blackberries and Blueberries are plump. Flavor is good.

Fresh Red Currants are available with a 2 day pre-order. Case size is 12 x 6oz

MELONS -

Plenty of varieties to choose from. Black Watermelon is in house. Nice flavor and color. Pricier than regular but good.



GRAPES -



CA production increasing. Quality is very good with Reds running a little on the small side.

Champagne Grapes coming very soon.

TOMATOES -



Very nice Single Layer Vine Ripe Tomatoes available in 15# flats.

Local Green Tomatoes available in 20lb cases by PRE-ORDER.
