VEGETABLES



LETTUCE ROMAINE / ICEBERG / LEAF -

High Heat will definitely cause quality issues with lettuces across the board. Romaine may be the hardest hit. Issues will include tip and fringe burn. Lettuces in general are most hurt by hot weather.



ASPARAGUS - Production out of Mexico is very steady and quality is good. The only issue so far is inconsistent sizing. Not much in the way of uniform Jumbo



BRUSSELS SPROUTS - Good production out of Oxnard / Salinas. Quality has been very nice.



CAULIFLOWER- Heads have been fairly clean and tight. No shortages being reported



BROCCOLI- Broccoli supplies are abundant out of Santa Maria and Salinas. Crowns are nice and firm.



CARROTS - Supplies in full swing out of Bakersfield. Sizing has been good.



CELERY - Mostly out of Santa Maria. There may be exterior scarring but quality overall is good.



ONIONS - Triple digit temperatures will have an affect on upcoming supplies. Quality issues may include "soft" heads.



SOFT SQUASH- Mixed Summer Squash has been nice and steady and quality is very good. The cases have a good selection of 4 or 5 different varieties. SoCal dealing with quality issues related to heat on Zucchini / Yellow Squash.

VEGETABLES / FRUITS



SEASONAL FRUITS - Black Mission Figs gapping for a couple weeks. Brown Turkey Figs are currently available.



AVOCADO - CA market seeing high demand for fruit. Mexico trying



CITRUS -
Lemons: Supplies have been steady out of Ventura
Limes: Great value. Sizing is still an issue with mostly 200ct fruit.

Oranges: Mostly Valencias



BERRIES
Strawberries: Very good production. Berries are mostly on the small to medium side with good color.

Raspberries: CA harvest decreasing out of Oxnard / Salinas. Santa Maria / Watsonville starting to ramp up production

Blackberries: Quality has been very good. Berries are firm with decent size.



MELONS -
Santa Claus / Galia / Crenshaw / Orange Flesh Honeydew and Casaba gives you plenty of options on the Melon front.



GRAPES -
Quality issues will include splits and skin discoloration. This is due to heat.



TOMATOES -
Local Cherry Tomatoes are available - lots of Mixed Toybox.
