## VEGETABLES

**\*\*\* Jimmy Nardello Peppers and Hatch Chile are on hand  
Red Endive - supplies improving**

**ASPARAGUS - Volume out of Mexico continues it's downward trend but quality is good. Price trending downward. Peru and Baja slow to start.**

**BRUSSELS SPROUTS - Supplies out of CA plentiful with no reported quality issues. Mexico is done.**

**EGGPLANT - Quality is improving and volume starting to increase. Prices remain on the higher side.**

**ONIONS - Production out of Central CA and New Mexico. Sizes trending towards small to medium due to heat. Market is fairly steady.**

*Green Onions: Heat keeping production down and affecting quality.*

**LETTUCE ROMAINE / ICEBERG / LEAF - Lettuces are bountiful due to higher production and low demand. Very good value right now.**

***Heads of Romaine are medium size and very green. Still getting reports of minor fringe burn.***

**HARD SQUASH - Butternut / Kabocha / Delicata and Spaghetti all available.**

**SOFT SQUASH - Mixed Toybox Squash limited for the next two weeks or so. Full size Summer and Sunburst Squash available but best to pre-order.**

## VEGETABLES / FRUITS

### SEASONAL FRUITS -

*Cherries and Apricots are done for the Season. Oregon Red Currants available with 2 day Pre-Order*

### AVOCADO -

*Supplies out of CA will be done by end of Month. Production out of Mexico is unsteady with large fruit scarce. Price trending upward.*

### CITRUS -

*Daisy Tangerines from Australia.*

*Oranges: Only Valencias*

*Limes: Prices inching up slowly due to last tropical storm.*

*Quality issues with Limes / Lemons and Grapefruit - will include brown spots on the skin, dry interior and soft spots.*

### BERRIES

*Strawberries: Watsonville has peaked. Berries are running small but flavor and color is very good. Santa Maria starting up.*

*Blueberries: Production has decreased due to wet weather in the growing regions and the season winding down. South America expecting to start in September.*

*Blackberries: Santa Maria / Oxnard finishing up with Salinas / Watsonville starting to ramp up production. Quality is good.*

### MELONS -

*Watermelon - low production is causing a short market.*

*Honeydew and Cantaloupe - good quality and availability.*

*Varietal Melons - steady with many choices available.*

### TOMATOES -

*Plenty of Heirloom and Toybox Cherry Tomatoes from local growers. Riverdog Farms has started with Early Girls.*
