VEGETABLES

Red Endive will be VERY limited going into the week.

ASPARAGUS - Volume has taken a dip. Quality is good.



BRUSSELS SPROUTS - Supplies out of CA plentiful. Mexico is just about done.



EGGPLANT - Quality issues expected with the recent heat. Harvesting issues keeping volume down.

ONIONS - Production out of Central CA and New Mexico. Sizes trending towards small to medium due to heat. Market is fairly steady.



Green Onions: Reports of light browning or yellowing tips with shipments out of Baja / Salinas. Heat keeping production down.

LETTUCE ROMAINE / ICEBERG / LEAF - Lettuces are bountiful due to higher production and low demand.



Heads of Romaine are medium size and very green. Still getting reports of minor fringe burn.

HARD SQUASH - Butternut / Kabocha and Spaghetti all available.



SOFT SQUASH - Mixed Toybox Squash going strong with a nice mix of varieties. Full size Summer and Sunburst Squash available but best to pre-order.



VEGETABLES / FRUITS

SEASONAL FRUITS -

*Black Mission Figs in house. Very sweet. Very nice Packham Pears on hand. Oregon Red Currants available with 2 day Pre-Order
Cherries are done for the Season*



AVOCADO -

Supplies out of CA starting to decline. Mexico harvesting good numbers.



CITRUS -

Daisy Tangerines from Australia. Very tasty but has a few seeds.



*Oranges: Quality of Valencias improving.
Limes: Still a very good deal.*

BERRIES

Strawberries: Watsonville is the main supplier. Berries are running small but flavor and color is very good.

Blueberries: Production has decreased due to wet weather in the growing regions and the season winding down. South America expecting to start in September.



Blackberries: Santa Maria / Oxnard finishing up with Salinas / Watsonville starting to ramp up production. Quality is good.

MELONS -

*Casaba, Crenshaw, Orange Flesh Honeydew, Santa Claus, Sharlyn, Charantais and Galia all available. Cataloupes - desert crop is done.
Honeydew- San Joaquin Valley harvest has begun
Watermelon - Yellow, Red and Black on hand*



TOMATOES -

Plenty of Heirloom and Toybox Cherry Tomatoes from local growers. Riverdog Farms has started with Early Girls and Vine Ripe 2 lyr Tomatoes.
