ASPARAGUS - Quality has taken a dip. Low harvest numbers out of Mexico and Peru. Due to recent Hurricane activity in Baja



BRUSSELS SPROUTS - Market has tightened up due to high demand.

EGGPLANT - Market is good on all varieties. Price steady.



ONIONS -
Green Onions: Harvest is down due to Heat and Hurricane damage. Supplies will remain light for the next week or two. Red Spring Onions are done.



LETTUCE ROMAINE / ICEBERG / LEAF -
Prices are steady across the board. Quality has been good.

Broccoli / Cauliflower / Celery -
Supplies are good except for Broccoli which has tightened up. Prices are still very reasonable.



HARD SQUASH-
Butternut / Kabocha / Org. Delicata / Org. Red Kuri / Spaghetti Squash and Organic Sugar Pie Pumpkins all available.



SOFT SQUASH-
Mixed Toybox Squash finishing up.
Baby Squashes short due to Hurricane.

VEGETABLES / FRUITS

SEASONAL FRUITS -

Black Mission Figs - may be done by months end.
Pink Pearls - what's on hand is it.

Pluots - done

Yellow Peaches / Nectarines - couple more weeks maybe.

White Peaches / Nectarines done by weeks end

AVOCADO -



Supplies out of CA dwindling rapidly. Production out of Mexico is unsteady with large fruit scarce. Price trending upward. This will continue until MX new crop starts in October.

CITRUS -



Murcott Mandarins are in house.

Limes: Prices inching up slowly due to last tropical storm.

Grapefruit - Quality diminishing quickly. Texas crop not expected until October.

Australian Blood Oranges on hand.

BERRIES -



Blueberries: Quality is taking a big hit due to fruit out of storage. Prices will remain high.

Stonefruit -

Marchini Ranch is done.

Quality will start to decline as the Stonefruit season winds down.

MELONS -

Watermelon - low production is causing a short market.

Yellow Watermelon is done.

Honeydew and Cantaloupe - good quality and availability.

Varietal Melons - Sharlyn and Casaba done.



TOMATOES -



Heirloom and Toybox Cherry Tomatoes will be steady for the next 2 weeks and then start to wind down.
